

Pool Rules in response to COVID-19 Operations; All Pool Rules are posted at the pool.

- The pool staff will stop permitting members from entering the facility at any time during the day if capacity is such that people cannot social distance. As people leave, others will be allowed to enter
- Families with purple badges, can only go to the pool on “purple” days. Likewise Families with green badges can only go on “green” days. See Families Schedule Calendar
- Practice proper social distancing and **wear a face covering when moving around the facility**
- Avoid over crowded areas; find or move to a less crowded area
- Frequently wash hands and use hand sanitizer; avoid touching your face; cough or sneeze into your elbow
- Only gather with family members Parents are responsible to ensure their children practice social distancing and practice hygiene guidelines

Modification to Operations

- Modifications have been made to the schedule to reduce number of people at the pool
- Patrons will enter through main gates and display membership badges to Gate Attendant
- Follow the arrows, signs, cones, barriers and hatch marks that delineate directions or distances.
- Refrain from touching surfaces as much as possible
- Drinking fountains have been disconnected
- High touch areas such as railings, door knobs, vending machines will be disinfected with a 70% alcohol base sanitizer or bleach solution throughout the day
- Non-breakable water bottles are allowed
- Staff will be monitored for symptoms and temperatures will be taken
- Aquatics Directors will monitor patrons for social distancing
- Announcements will be made throughout the day regarding policies, rules and modifications included stopping admittance.
- Picnic tables and benches have been spread apart and some placed outside the complex.
- Adult swim will take place at the top of even numbered hours for 15 minutes (2:00, 4:00, 6:00pm) 2 people per swim lane
